‘No Where is far in a TR!’

Kennet Valley TR Group members had a very interesting mid-monthly visit to the original Greenham Common Airbase Control Tower.

RAF Greenham Common was built in 1940 as a WW2 airbase, but hit the headlines in 1981 as the base for the first US Ground Launched Cruise Missiles to be sited in the UK, and the protest movement against this carried on for 20 years night and day, through all weathers. The camp was always peopled by women, who were in many headline-grabbing encounters with the police. At one point over 50,000 women encircled the base, sadly one lost her life as a vehicle was entering the base.

CONTROL TOWER

The Air Traffic Control Tower staff directed and supervised aircraft and vehicles. They did this using information provided by Ground and Air Control, Radar and Meteorology departments.

INSIDE THE TOWER

GROUND CONTROL
Ground Control gave radio clearance to trucks, repair vehicles and taxis, holding aircraft in taxiways, holding aircraft in parking areas. Pilots had to use light signals with radios.

OBSERVATION ROOM

Air (or Tower) Control managed the runways, clearing aircraft for takeoff and landing while considering flight paths and weather conditions.

Allan Westbury, Acting Chairman opened the meeting with a welcome to the attendees and to record any apologies.

The voting procedure for the meeting was outlined and Acting Chairman Allan Westbury declared a poll on the contested director's positions and all resolutions. However, at this point five members from the meeting requested a poll on all positions, which was granted.

AGM Resolutions results



Resolutions: The results of the voting on resolutions were as follows:

Special resolutions (requiring 75% majority).

9.1. Chairman to have a vote at Directors board meetings. For: 646, Against: 58, **92% in favour – motion therefore carried.**

9.2. Proposed new clauses 17(4 & 5) regarding the election & maximum term of office for the Chairman. For: 564, Against: 145, **80% in favour – motion therefore carried.**

9.3. A requirement for all Directors to undergo a Disclosure & Barring Service check.

For: 614, Against: 93, **87% in favour – motion therefore carried.**

9.4. To introduce an independent review before any member can be suspended or expelled from the club.

For: 687, Against: 26, **96% in favour – motion therefore carried.**

9.5. Limitation of Directors' tenure. For: 256, Against: 437, **63% against – rejected.**

9.6 Directors expenses. For: 683, Against: 29, **96% in favour – motion therefore carried.**

9.7 Board co-opting and voting. For: 285, Against: 407, **59% against – rejected.**

9.8 Right to inspect the accounts and other records. For: 267, Against: 431, **62% against – rejected.**

Ordinary Resolutions (requiring a simple majority).

9.9 The adoption of new Forum Rules for all users and members. For: 538, Against: 169, **76% in favour – motion carried.**

9.10 To create a new forum within the 'TR Register Technical Forum' titled Alec's Inn. For: 225, Against: 476, **68% against – rejected.**

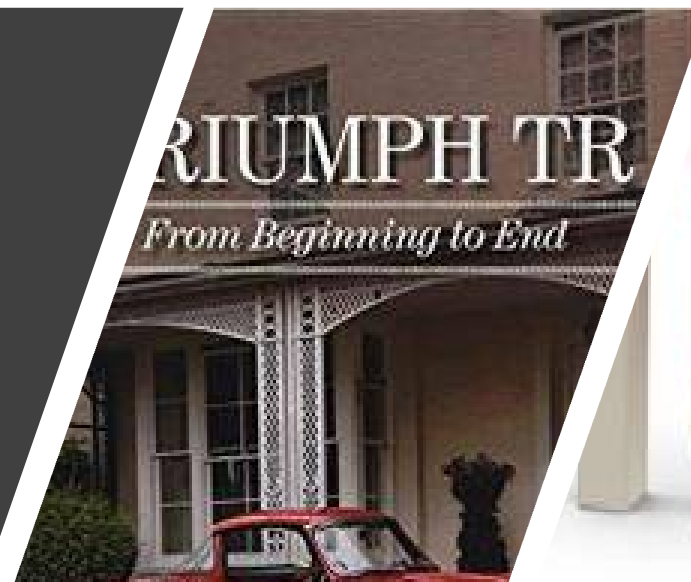
