

Minutes of TRR LVG E.C.M. 1st September 2020

(Held using Zoom video conference, hosted by Phil Sanford)

Attendees: Phil Sanford, Mike Aldridge (Chairman), Pierre Miles, Brian Chidwick, David Dawson, Chris Glasbey, Jon Marshall

Agenda To discuss the name for the new LVG email address and matters arising.

Mike outlined his discussion with Mick Foray with the following points highlighted:

1. We can use Gmail which will allow us to send emails to large groups with very little problem, thus saving us from using MailChimp.
2. We should only use 1 email address for the group.
3. It is easy to group addresses together for certain uses such as AMM calling, Kick off Lunch.
4. All addresses should be bcc to keep privacy.
5. GDPR does not cover inanimate objects so we can keep details of members cars.
6. The TRR policies which have been flagged as under review do not relate to anything that are under discussion by the LVG Committee.

There was then a discussion to settle on the new email address for the group and it was settled on as trr-lvg@gmail.com The password would be the same as Pierre and Brian are currently using. It was agreed that Mike would set up the Gmail account and do some trial emails out to the committee. Once we are happy with it Mike will arrange with Jo at the Register to send out an up to date LVG Members list. We will then use this list to email LVG members only, explaining the migration over to the new email and including the revised GDPR document. This would then be followed to an email in the same vein to the “friends and followers” of the LVG.

The initial email address list would be comprised of the current data provided by the office at Didcot and then the friends and followers would be added. This will give us the capability of only sending to paid up LVG members, when required in certain instances.

It was agreed that the LVG could make members aware of car meets and shows that are happening locally via the WhatsApp group. There would be the proviso that all of the events are in no way connected to the TRR or LVG and anyone attending would do so at their own risk as the TRR insurance would not cover them. The LVG banner would not be flown at any event. To be covered by the TRR insurance any event has to be advertised on the TRR website.

There was some discussion regarding the minutes of the Committee Meeting held on 30th July 2020. It was agreed that as it was not clear in the minutes what conclusion, regarding GDPR and members data base, was reached. David Dawson was asked to submit a revision of the minute. The date of the meeting was also incorrect and should be 30th July 2020.

The new committee profiles have been added to the TRR LVG website as an attachment associated with the August edition of TRunion. A discussion took place if they should have their own tab under a "Team" heading or added to the "About" page. Mike suggested we add this to the agenda for the next meeting with a review on what we have published where and how on our Register pages.

There being no further business meeting was closed at 12.07
