





My TR6 Pop Video



I arrived at 7pm, the weather was perfect, Jodrell Bank Car Park was empty except for us.

The Videographer wanted footage of Chloe driving the car, so an an-hoc driving lesson was arranged in the car park, this was a bit of a worry as a 36-year-old who is only used to driving a modern small hatchback was about to get to grips with a 1971 TR6 with all its foibles in a car park!
